Each lesson should end with: This is the Word of the Lord or The Word of the Lord

Presenting the Psalms: They can be read (1) by the half verse; (2) solely by the reader; or (3) verse by verse between the Reader and the congregation.

If reading the Psalm from the BCP (Book of Common Prayer): end Psalm with “In the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. AMEN.”

If reading the Psalm from the BAS (Book of Alternative Services): end Psalm with the prayer which follows the Psalm. This may be read (1) all together; or (2) by the reader only.
