**Isaiah 55:1-9** - In a hymn of joy and triumph, the prophet celebrates the approaching consummation of Israel's restoration, and invites all people to share in the abundant life of the people of God.

**1 Corinthians 10:1-13** - Our reading is a warning against overconfidence: baptism and partaking in the Lord's supper do not guarantee salvation anymore than perhaps analogous events the Israelites experienced during the Exodus.
